Null Fever Pamphlet

Overview

Null Sickness or “Null Fever” is a life-threatening condition that results from significant exposure to the nuclei of a Nullstar or its smaller “Fragments” undergoing fission. This breakdown involves the dark outer matter falling apart and masking itself into the surrounding environment. This condition mostly occurs in pilots, engineers or wholesalers mishandling Null Fragment storage receptacles.

Symptoms

Symptoms tend to begin days after initial exposure. Every affected patient tends to start feeling feverish (hence the name “Null Fever”). If exposure continues, this accelerates the appearance and severity of symptoms.

The most common symptoms of Null Sickness include:
